Trees increase property values, cool our homes, reduce street noise and clean the air

Trees are available from Blue Water Baltimore for \$0 installed!

Street Trees – for the strip between sidewalk and curb

- To get a street tree, you must have a distance of 6' from curb to sidewalk – Hillcrest Avenue, Canterbury Road, and Park Drive are eligible
- The trees we select are off the County's approved list and it is limited
- You will not pick the species when you register on the website, only the quantity of trees – BWB will follow up with you regarding availability

Yard Trees

Select a tree from the following varieties:

- American Holly
- Bald Cypress
- Black Gum
- Eastern Red Cedar
- Hackberry
- Northern Red Oak
- River Birch

- Sassafras
- Shingle Oak
- Swamp White Oak
- Southern Magnolia
- Tulip Poplar
- White Pine
- Willow Oak

Understory trees for under power lines and small yards:

- Hop Hornbeam
- Redbud
- Serviceberry
- Sweetbay Magnolia for wet locations
